# KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program

According to local KISD Board Policy EIE, grade-level advancement for students in grades 9-12 shall be earned by course credits. Students must earn a grade of 70 or higher and meet the State’s compulsory attendance requirements (90% Rule) in each course to earn credit.

For year-long courses (two semesters), KISD Board Policy EI (LOCAL) states that students may earn partial or full credit:

- When a student earns a passing grade in only one semester of a two-semester course and the combined grade for the two semesters is lower than 70, the District shall award the student credit for the semester with the passing grade. The student shall be required to retake only the semester in which he or she earned the failing grade.
- When a student’s combined average for the two semesters of a course is 70 or higher, the student shall be awarded 1 full credit even if the grade for one semester is below 70.

Students who fail to earn partial or full credit for one or more courses will have the opportunity to attend the Kennedale High School Summer Credit Recovery Program. The Kennedale High School Summer Credit Recovery program is accredited and designed to provide students an opportunity to earn credit for courses which the student did not pass during the regular school year. Courses are offered in an online format through the web-based system, Edgenuity. Students will complete credit recovery courses at home, and certified teachers will facilitate learning and provide general assistance to students virtually. The KHS Credit Recovery Program will have a Google Classroom to support students, and teachers will have regular, virtual office hours (Monday through Thursday).

Kennedale High School will charge for credit recovery courses in 2020:

- **The first semester credit recovery course (.5 credit) will cost students \$50 (free for students who qualify for the National School Lunch Program).**
- **Each additional semester credit recovery course (.5 credit) will cost students \$25 (free for students who qualify for the National School Lunch Program).**
- Payment must be made with cash or check in the KHS Front Office beginning **Monday, June 1, 2020 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.**
- Students have until **Thursday, June 4, 2020** to pay for their first summer credit recovery course(s), or students will be removed from courses until payment is received.
- Payment plans are not available; however, students may add courses throughout the summer term and pay for additional courses when added.
- Students who need to recover credits but do not attend summer school will have to retake courses in future years to meet graduation requirements.

## Dates and Times:

The KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program is an online, four-week program from **Monday, June 1, 2020, to Thursday, June 25, 2020**. Certified teachers will be available to assist students through virtual office hours on **Mondays through Thursdays from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm**.

### **Important Information:**

- KHS will make every effort to contact students and parents regarding the need for students to attend summer school and recover credits; however, students and parents should monitor final grades using the Ascender Parent Portal and/or final KHS Report Cards.
- Final KHS Report Cards for 2019-20 will be mailed home to parents on **Friday, May 29, 2020**.
- Students have the flexibility to work on course modules at home when convenient; however, tests and quizzes must be taken from **8:00 am to 12:00 pm** on **Mondays through Thursdays**. Teachers will provide passwords to access tests and quizzes.
- Students must complete all summer credit recovery course work by **Thursday, June 25, 2020**. All credits recovered by **Thursday, June 25, 2020**, will be applied to transcripts and used for grade promotion and graduation purposes.
- Students who do not complete courses by **Thursday, June 25, 2020**, will have the opportunity to complete courses in the KHS Fresh Start Program during the fall semester when school resumes.
- Students are expected to have regular, daily attendance in the KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program until courses are complete. Teachers will take attendance daily, and attendance will be considered by KHS when awarding course credit.
  - Students who plan to be absent during the KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program must seek prior approval from a campus administrator.
  - Students must provide written notes from parents or doctors to excuse absences.
- Students should check-in with teachers in the KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program Google Classroom between **8:00 am and 9:00 am** each day.
  - After **9:00 am**, students will be counted absent.
  - Students who plan to have partial absences or will be late must make prior arrangements (typically at least one day in advance) with a KHS Credit Recovery administrator or teacher.
- Students are expected to adhere to the KISD Student Code of Conduct and KISD Acceptable Use Policy and follow rules, procedures, and guidelines established by the KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program teachers.

# KHS 2020 Summer Accelerated Instruction Program

KISD Board Policy EKB states that a district shall provide each student who fails to perform satisfactorily on an EOC assessment instrument with accelerated instruction in the subject assessed by the assessment instrument. Because accelerated instruction programs are required by the State, the KHS 2020 Summer Accelerated Instruction Program is **free of charge** to students.

Although TEA has waived requirements for STAAR testing requirements for 2019-20 because of COVID-19, students in grades 9-11 who have not passed one or more STAAR EOC exams will be expected to pass these exams to meet graduation requirements in future years. The Kennedale High School 2020 Accelerated Instruction Program is designed to provide remediation and STAAR EOC test preparation for all students.

STAAR EOC test preparation and remediation/intervention courses are offered in an online format through the web-based system, Edgenuity. Students will complete accelerated instruction courses at home, and certified teachers will facilitate learning and provide general assistance to students virtually. The KHS Summer Accelerated Instruction Program will have a Google Classroom to support students, and teachers will have regular, virtual office hours (Monday through Thursday).

Kennedale High School will make every effort to contact parents of students who have not passed EOC courses and should attend the KHS 2020 Summer Accelerated Instruction Program, beginning on Wednesday, May 27, 2020.

# KHS 2020 Summer National and State Test Preparation Program

The newest addition to KHS Summer Programs is the KHS 2020 Summer National and State Test Preparation Program. In 2019-20, the KHS Campus Advisory Team (CAT) identified the need to improve student participation and performance on State and National Tests. The KHS 2020 Summer National and State Test Preparation Program seeks to provide students with opportunities to prepare for State and National tests such as the PSAT, SAT, ACT, TSIA, and ASVAB. The KHS 2020 Summer National and State Test Preparation Program supports the KISD Board Goal of ensuring that all KISD students meet College, Career, and Military Readiness standards.

The KHS 2020 Summer National and State Test Preparation Program is **free of charge** to students. Preparation courses will be available online through Edgenuity. Students will complete test preparation courses at home, and KHS Counselors will facilitate learning and provide general assistance to students virtually. The KHS Summer National and State Test Preparation Program will have a Google Classroom to support students, and counselors will have regular, virtual office hours (Monday through Thursday).

## Texas Test Preparation Courses:

Edgenuity offers preparation courses for the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Assessment, for which students must meet minimum standards for acceptance into most State colleges and universities. KHS students who plan to enroll in Dual Credit courses at the TCC-South Campus must take the TSI prior to enrollment.

- Students who score greater than or equal to a 351 on the Reading and greater than or equal to a 350 on the Math sections of the TSI Assessment meet the State’s college readiness standards for these subjects, respectively.

## National Test Preparation Courses:

Edgenuity offers preparation courses for several National tests used to gauge college and military readiness including the PSAT, SAT, ACT, and ASVAB. Students must meet minimum standards on the ACT and SAT for acceptance into most State and National, public and private colleges and universities. Students must meet minimum requirements on the ASVAB prior to enlistment in the U.S. Military.

- Students who score greater than or equal to a 480 on the Reading and greater than or equal to a 530 on the Math sections of the SAT meet the State's college readiness standards for these subjects, respectively.
- Students who score greater than or equal to a 19 on the English and greater than or equal to a 19 on the Math sections of the ACT meet the State's college readiness standards for these subjects, respectively. Students who score a composite score of greater than or equal to the 23 meet the State's college readiness standards for both subjects.

# KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program

KISD Board Policies FEA, FEB, and FEC address the State's compulsory attendance laws, which, under normal circumstances, require students to be in attendance for each class period/course at least 90% of the instructional days for which the course is offered (also known as the 90% Rule). Refer to KISD Board Policies FEA, FEB, and FEC for details, exceptions, information regarding Attendance Committees, and opportunities for attendance recovery/make-up. Under these policies, KHS Attendance Committees and the campus principal have the authority to make decisions regarding attendance and opportunities for students to make-up attendance hours.

KHS students will not be awarded credit for courses for which they did not meet the State's compulsory attendance requirements, until the student has made-up the required number of hours or met the requirements determined by an Attendance Committee. Parents who wish to discuss a student's attendance in an Attendance Committee meeting should make a written request to the campus principal or the designated attendance official/truancy officer. **The KHS Campus Principal, Michael Cagle, has authorized that, during the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program, KHS students (grades 9-12) will have the opportunity to make-attendance hours for courses taken during the 2019-20 school year for which students passed (made grades of 70 or higher) but did not meet the State's compulsory attendance requirements.**

The KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program will be facilitated by Kennedale High School administrators. Participating students will earn make-up hours through virtual participation in one or more of the other KHS 2020 Summer Programs or other activities, as determined and approved by a KHS administrator:

- **KHS 2020 Credit Recovery Program**
- **KHS 2020 Accelerated Instruction Program**
- **KHS 2020 National and State Test Preparation Program**
- **KHS 2020 Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) Program**
- **Other Approved Activity/Program**

## **Attendance Credit:**

During the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program, students will be awarded **2 hours of attendance credit for each hour (1 hour) of approved and documented participation in one or more KHS 2020 Summer Programs. The final day for students to earn attendance credit for the 2019-20 school year is Thursday, June 25, 2020.** Participating students may only receive attendance credit during the designated hours of the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program.

**NOTE:** The KHS Summer Attendance Make-Up Program operates for a total of 16 days and 64 hours; therefore, a maximum of 128 hours can be recaptured during the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program. However, students who attend all days (and hours) of the KHS Attendance Make-Up Program and who need more than 128 make-up hours will be considered by the campus principal as having met all attendance make-up hours, if courses were passed (grades of 70 or higher) during the semester/year (2019-20).



## Cost:

Students will **not** be charged to attend the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program; however, students who participate in the KHS 2020 Summer Credit Recovery Program to make-up hours will be charged for the costs of credit recovery courses.

## Dates and Times:

The KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program is an online, four-week program from **Monday, June 1, 2020, to Thursday, June 25, 2020**. KHS Assistant Principals will be available to assist students **Mondays through Thursdays** from **8:00 am to 12:00 pm**.

- Students are expected to attend the KHS 2020 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program each day until all needed make-up hours are earned. KHS Assistant Principals will take attendance daily, and attendance make-up logs will be maintained.
  - Students who plan to be absent during KHS Summer Programs must seek prior approval from a campus administrator.
