| GREEN | MINIMAL MITIGATION | STATE OR LOCAL ORDERS MANDATE THE FOLLOWING: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ STEADY DECLINE IN CASES DETERMINED BY LOCAL HEALTH AUTHORITY DATA. ■ FEW LIMITS TO BUSINESSES, WORKPLACES OR LARGE GROUP GATHERINGS. ■ COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL HEALTH OFFICIALS. | LEAST RESTRICTIVE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ FACE COVERINGS RECOMMENDED ONLY ■ VISITORS ALLOWED BUT SUBJECT TO SCREENING PROTOCOLS. ■ HAND WASHING/SANITIZER THROUGHOUT THE DAY |
