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The summer credit recovery program is for students who have taken a required course and not made a passing grade. Completion of the program with a passing grade allows students to recover a course credit required for graduation.

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The summer accelerated instruction program is for students who have taken a STAAR/EOC and not met the passing standard required for graduation. Completing the required instruction in the summer prepares the student for success when retaking the EOC.

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The summer attendance make-up program is for students who may not receive credit for the successful completion of a course due to not meeting the state attendance requirements.

KHS 2022 Summer Credit Recovery Program

According to local KISD Board Policy EIE, grade-level advancement for students in grades 9-12 shall be earned by course credits. Students must earn a grade of 70 or higher and meet the State's compulsory attendance requirements (90% Rule) in each course to earn credit.

For year-long courses (two semesters), KISD Board Policy EI (LOCAL) states that students may earn partial or full credit:

- When a student earns a passing grade in only one semester of a two-semester course and the combined grade for the two semesters is lower than 70, the District shall award the student credit for the semester with the passing grade. The student shall be required to retake only the semester in which he or she earned the failing grade.
- When a student's combined average for the two semesters of a course is 70 or higher, the student shall be awarded 1 full credit even if the grade for one semester is below 70.

Students who fail to earn partial or full credit for one or more courses will have the opportunity to attend the Kennedale High School Summer Credit Recovery Program. The Kennedale High School Summer Credit Recovery program is accredited and designed to provide students an opportunity to earn credit for courses which the student did not pass during the regular school year. Courses are offered in an online format through the web-based system, Edgenuity. See [Edgenuity for families](#). Students will complete the courses **on campus**, and a certified teacher will be available to facilitate learning and provide support to students. Students may also work on courses at any time outside of the designated summer program hours, however all quizzes and tests must be taken on campus during designated summer program hours. Teachers will be available only during designated hours.

Students who need to recover credits but do not attend summer school will have to retake courses in future years to meet graduation requirements.

Cost and Payment for Credit Recovery courses:

- The fee for one semester course (.5 credit) is \$100 (\$50 for students who qualify for the National School Lunch Program).
- The fee for each additional course for the same student is \$50 (\$25 for students who qualify for the National School Lunch Program).
- Payment must be received in full before students are allowed to start credit recovery courses.

KHS will host two sessions to accommodate students: **8:00 am to 11:30 am (AM Session) and 12:00 pm to 3:30 pm (PM Session)**. Students may attend morning, afternoon, or both, depending on the requirements for each student.

Important Information:

- KHS will make every effort to contact students and parents regarding the need for students to attend summer school and recover credits; however, students and parents should monitor final grades using the Ascender Parent Portal and/or final KHS Report Cards.
- KHS Final Report Cards for 2021-22 will be available in the Ascender Student and Parent Portals on **Friday, June 3, 2022**.
- Students must complete all summer credit recovery course work by **Thursday, June 23, 2022**. All credits recovered by **Thursday, June 23, 2022**, will be applied to transcripts and used for grade promotion and graduation purposes.
- Students in grades 11-12 who do not complete courses by **Thursday, June 23, 2022**, will have the opportunity to complete courses in the KHS Fresh Start Program during the fall semester when school resumes.
- Students are expected to have regular, daily attendance in the KHS 2022 Summer Credit Recovery Program until courses are complete. Teachers will take attendance daily, and attendance will be considered by KHS when awarding course credit.
 - Students who plan to be absent during the KHS 2022 Summer Credit Recovery Program must seek prior approval from a campus administrator.

- Students must provide written notes from parents or doctors to excuse absences.
- Students who plan to have partial absences or will be late must make prior arrangements (typically at least one day in advance) with a KHS Credit Recovery administrator or teacher.
- Students are expected to adhere to the KISD Student Code of Conduct and KISD Acceptable Use Policy and follow rules, procedures, and guidelines established by the KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program teachers.
 - Students who do not follow the KISD Student Code of Conduct or who violate the KISD Acceptable Use Policy are subject to disciplinary action by KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program staff, teachers, and/or campus administrators.
 - Persistent misbehavior, major violations of the disciplinary rules, the KISD Student Code of Conduct, and/or the KISD Acceptable Use Policy, major disruptions of the educational environment, and/or lack of adequate progress toward course completion may result in removal from the KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program.
- Students must make adequate progress toward completion of credit recovery courses to remain in the KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program.
 - **At the half-way mark (two weeks), students who have not made 50% progress toward completion of their credit recovery courses may be removed from the KHS Summer Credit Recovery Program.**

KHS 2021 Summer Accelerated Instruction Program

KISD Board Policy EKB, in compliance with state law, says that a district shall provide each student who fails to perform satisfactorily on an EOC assessment instrument with accelerated instruction in the subject assessed by the assessment instrument. House Bill 4545, which became effective in June 2021, requires any student who did not pass STAAR grades 3-8 or EOC assessments to complete 30 hours of accelerated instruction for each subject area that the student did not meet the State's passing standard (minimum score of "approaches" grade level).

Students in grades 9-11 who have not passed one or more STAAR EOC exams (or met exam credit requirements in 2021-22) will be expected to pass these exams to meet the State's graduation requirements. The Kennedale High School 2022 Accelerated Instruction Program is designed to prepare students for success on these required EOC assessments. Accelerated instruction may be provided through both online courseware and teacher-based lessons.

Because accelerated instruction programs are required by the State, the KHS 2022 Summer Accelerated Instruction Program is **free** of charge. Students who do not complete or partially complete the required 30 hours per course must complete the 30 hours in the Fall semester.

Kennedale High School will contact parents of students who have not passed EOC assessments beginning on Thursday, May 26, 2022. Parents may view a student's past EOC scores on the Texas Assessment Family Portal. Scores for 2022 will be available in the portal in mid to late June.

- Enter the 6-character access code and student date of birth and click Sign On. The access code can be found at the bottom of the STAAR Confidential Student Report from any previous year. .
- If you do not have the access code, you can look it up by entering your child's first name, social security number and date of birth.

KHS 2022 Accelerated Instruction Program Registration:

HB 4545 requires that the accelerated instruction (tutoring) be provided to students individually or in a group of no more than three students per one tutor unless the parent signs a waiver. With a parent signed waiver, the school can provide the accelerated instruction (tutoring) in groups larger than three if the school system feels a larger group will meet the child's needs.

When you register for the summer Accelerated Instruction Program, you will be asked to sign a waiver. You can choose to sign the waiver or decline.

- KHS administrators and counselors, will make attempts in writing, by phone, and via email to contact parents to encourage students who did not perform satisfactorily on one or more of the STAAR EOC Exams to participate in summer accelerated learning.

- For qualifying students, the 30 hours of accelerated instruction for each EOC not meeting the standard is required and subject to compulsory attendance requirements. Students who do not attend summer school for required accelerated instruction will need to attend tutoring in the Fall semester.

KHS 2021 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program

KISD Board Policies FEA, FEB, and FEC address the State's compulsory attendance laws, which, under normal circumstances, require students to be in attendance for each class period/course at least 90% of the instructional days for which the course is offered (also known as the 90% Rule). Refer to KISD Board Policies FEA, FEB, and FEC for details, exceptions, information regarding Attendance Committees, and opportunities for attendance recovery/make-up. Under these policies, KHS Attendance Committees and the campus principal have the authority to make decisions regarding attendance and opportunities for students to make-up attendance hours.

KHS students will not be awarded credit for courses for which they did not meet the State's compulsory attendance requirements, until the student has made-up the required number of hours or met the requirements determined by an Attendance Committee. Parents who wish to discuss a student's attendance in an Attendance Committee meeting should make a written request to the campus principal or the designated attendance official/truancy officer. Such requests can be made to Michael Cagle, KHS Principal, at caglem@kisdtx.net.

The KHS Campus Principal, Michael Cagle, has authorized that, during the KHS 2022 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program, KHS students (grades 9-12) will have the opportunity to make-attendance hours for courses taken during the 2021-22 school year for which students passed (made grades of 70 or higher) but did not meet the State's compulsory attendance requirements.

The KHS 2021 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program will be facilitated by Kennedale High School administrators. Participating students will earn make-up hours through in-person (on campus) participation in one or more of the other KHS 2021 Summer Programs or other activities, as determined and approved by a KHS administrator:

- **KHS 2022 Credit Recovery Program**
- **KHS 2022 Accelerated Instruction Program**
- **Other Approved Activity/Program**

Students must provide their own transportation to and from campus.

Attendance Credit:

During the KHS 2022 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program, students will be awarded **2 hours of attendance credit for each hour (1 hour) of approved and documented participation in one or more KHS 2022 Summer Programs. The final day for students to earn attendance credit for Semester 2 of the 2021-22 school year is Thursday, June 23, 2022.** Participating students may only receive attendance credit during the designated hours of the KHS 2021 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program.



NOTE: The KHS Summer Attendance Make-Up Program operates for a total of 15 days and 75 hours; therefore, a maximum of 150 hours can be recaptured during the KHS 2022 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program. However, students who attend all days (and hours) of the KHS Attendance Make-Up Program and who need more than 120 make-up hours will be considered by the campus principal as having met all attendance make-up hours, if courses were passed (grades of 70 or higher) during the semester/year (2021-22).

Cost:

Students will **not** be charged a fee to attend the KHS 2021 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program; however, students who participate in the KHS 2021 Summer Credit Recovery Program to make-up hours will be charged for the costs of credit recovery courses.

The KHS Attendance Make-Up program will be from **June 1, 2022 to June 23, 2022**, from **8:00 am to 3:30 pm**.

- Attendance make-up hours for courses taken in 2021-22 will **not** be accepted after **Thursday, June 23, 2022**.
- All credits recovered by **Thursday, June 23, 2022**, will be applied to transcripts and used for grade promotion and graduation purposes.
- Students are expected to attend the KHS 2022 Summer Attendance Make-Up Program each day until all needed make-up hours are earned. KHS Assistant Principals will take attendance daily, and attendance make-up logs will be maintained.
 - Students who plan to be absent during KHS Summer Programs must seek prior approval from a campus administrator.
 - Students must provide written notes from parents or doctors to excuse absences.
 - The KHS 2022 Summer Attendance Make-up Program begins at **8:00 am** each day.
 - Students are to report daily to the KHS Assistant Principals in their assigned classrooms.
 - Students will be given a **15-minute grace period** for daily attendance.
 - Students who check in after **8:30 am** will not be given attendance credit for that day.
 - Students who plan to have partial absences (or will be late on a given day) must make prior arrangements with a KHS Assistant Principal.
- Students are expected to adhere to the KISD Student Code of Conduct and KISD Acceptable Use Policy and follow rules, procedures, and guidelines established by the KHS Summer Attendance Make-Up Program teachers.
 - Students who do not follow the KISD Student Code of Conduct or who violate the KISD Acceptable Use Policy are subject to disciplinary action by KHS Summer Attendance Make-Up staff, teachers, and/or campus administrators.
 - Persistent misbehavior, major violations of the disciplinary rules, the KISD Student Code of Conduct, and/or the KISD Acceptable Use Policy, and/or major disruptions of the educational environment may result in removal from the KHS Summer Attendance Make-Up Program.
 - Students must actively participate in a KHS 2022 Summer Program or other approved program (by a KHS Administrator) to receive attendance credit. Students who do not actively participate will not receive attendance make-up credit.
