Transportation (Bus) Routes

Bus Route/Stop Procedures:

- ❖ Students must live at least 2 miles from their campus to be eligible for transportation
- ❖ Students may only ride between their registered home address and campus attended
- ❖ Bus stops are located as effectively as possible, however students may be expected to walk to their nearest stop up to:
 - 0.25 mile for Elementary/Intermediate School
 - 0.50 mile for Jr. High School
 - 0.75 mile for High School
- ❖ Bus routes are planned according to these considerations:
 - Even distribution of stops throughout neighborhoods
 - Safety of bus stops locations
 - New students and district growth
- ❖ Bus routes cannot be changed:
 - Based on a particular student or family
 - Bus stop is not visible from student's home
 - Relocation of student during current school year

Goldstar Transit Bus Rules

The district makes school bus transportation available to all students living two or more miles from school. This service is provided at no cost to the students.

Bus routes and stops will be designated annually, and any subsequent changes will be posted at the school. For the safety of the operator of the vehicle and all passengers, students must board buses only at authorized stops, and drivers must unload passengers only at authorized stops.

See the Student Code of Conduct for provisions regarding transportation to the DAEP.

Students are expected to assist district staff in ensuring that buses remain in good condition and that transportation is provided safely. Goldstar Transit is authorized by KISD to handle any disciplinary issues that may occur while students are using this service.

When riding in school buses, students are held to the dress code and behavioral standards established in the KISD Student Handbook and the Student Code of Conduct.

Goldstar Transit Bus Discipline

Should a student's behavior require more than verbal communication from the driver, the following formal corrective action procedures will be used:

- ❖ **1st Offense:** Parent/Guardian will be contacted to inform them of the behavioral issue.
- ❖ **2nd Offense:** Safety Report issued; Parent/Guardian will be contacted, along with district personnel.
- ❖ **3rd Offense:** Safety Report issued; Parent/Guardian will be contacted, along with district personnel. Student will lose bus service for up to 15 days (Elementary/Intermediate students), or up to 30 days (Jr. High and High school students). *****This is negotiable with parent involvement.*****
- ❖ **4th Offense:** Safety Report issued, copy sent to the parent/guardian contacted, along with district personnel. Student could potentially lose bus service for the remainder of the school year.

If a student is caught fighting or brings a weapon on the bus, an immediate loss of bus privileges will be issued, the parents/guardians will be notified, along with district personnel.

No Ineligible or guest riders are allowed. If an ineligible or guest rider is discovered, the parents/guardians will be notified and corrective action will be taken.

Student Code of Conduct-Bus



Parents/Guardians: Please read this form, initial next to each statement and sign at the bottom. Email the Code of Conduct-Bus, along with the KISD Student Transportation Request form to KISDdispatch@ridegst.com get your student signed up for bus transportation.

Students must comply with the following:

- _____ Students are required to be outside at their stop at least 5 minutes prior to scheduled time.
- _____ Students must wait for driver’s signal upon entering or leaving the bus and before crossing in front of the vehicle. Stay out of the bus “Danger Zone”-anywhere within 10 ft of the bus. **If you can touch the bus as you walk by, you are too close.**
- _____ Students will have an assigned seat to and from school. The bus driver has the right to change if necessary.
- _____ Students must fasten their seat belts, if available.
- _____ Students must stay in his/her seat and facing forward at all times.
- _____ Students must follow the driver’s directions **at all times.**
- _____ Items not allowed on the bus include, but are not limited to: weapons of any type, knives or any sharp object, skateboards, scooter, balloons, glass, lighters, large band instruments, live animals, reptiles or insects (dead or alive). Pencils and pens should not be displayed. **If it is not allowed at school, it not allowed on the bus.**
- _____ Students may not possess or use any form of tobacco including e-cigarettes on school buses.
- _____ Students may not bring aerosols, perfumes, lotions, or sprays of any kind on the bus.
- _____ Students may not eat or drink on the bus, except for water.
- _____ Students may not deface or destroy the bus or its equipment. Students and parents will be held responsible for all charges related to repair caused by vandalism or destruction.
- _____ Students must keep the noise level down to a minimum.
- _____ There is no horse-playing on the bus or around the outside of the bus.
- _____ Students may not put head, hands, arms, or legs out of the window. No holding objects out of the window or throwing objects within or out of the bus.
- _____ Students will keep his/her feet, books, backpacks, instrument cases and other objects out of the aisle. If possible, items must be held in your lap.
- _____ Students will observe all usual classroom rules.
- _____ Students will always cross the street in front of the bus. Make eye contact with your driver before crossing in front of the bus and the street. Be alert to the traffic around you.
- _____ Students will never try to get anything left on the bus after exiting and **NEVER** reach for anything you drop that goes under the bus.
- _____ Cell phones are allowed except for **No Photographs or Video recordings** due to privacy laws.
